

- 9. No gas golf carts, scooters, four-wheelers, or ATVs.
- 10. No fireworks of any type, including sparklers.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in public.
- 12. NO SMOKING IN RESTROOM OR SHOWER HOUSE.
- 13. RVs must have a minimum distance of 15 feet between them when on all campsites. Only one camping unit is permitted on each site.


