Labor Day Weekend



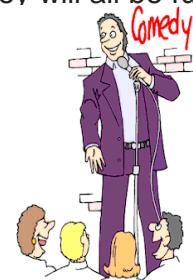

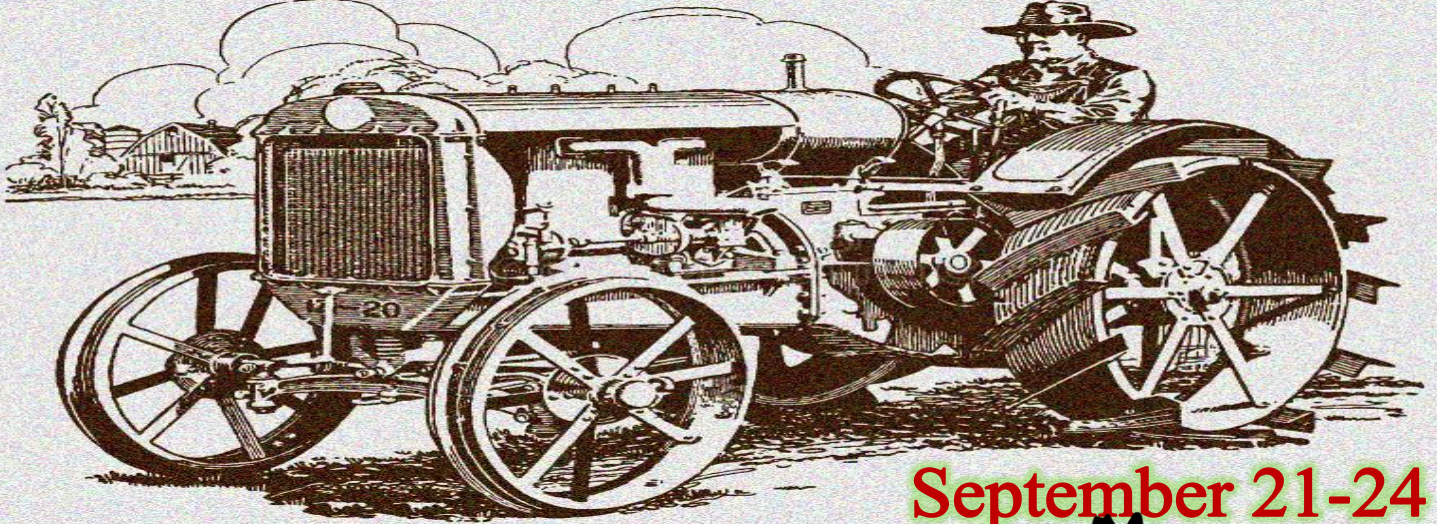

I hope that the future affords us many more opportunities to make great memories together. Love you both!



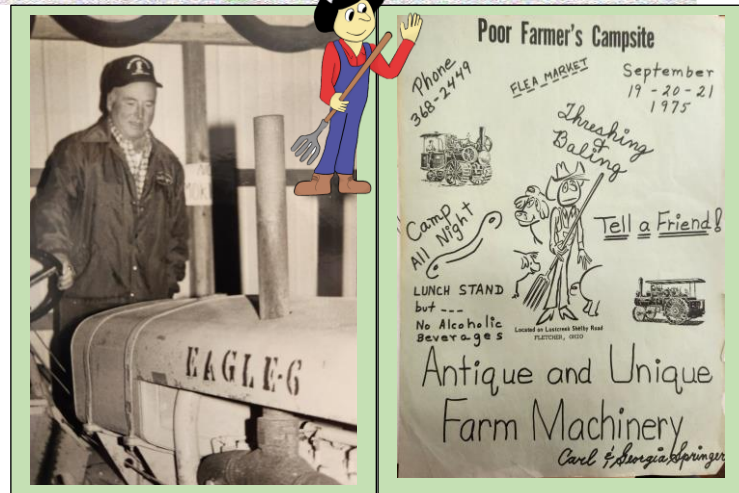
