Your seasonal camping fee for 2026 (With 2025 electric paid**), is only \$1300.00 if paid before March 1st. That is a huge savings!

Second, be sure to come into the store and check out the liquidation sale we are having. Any stickered item in the store is 25% off. Stop in soon as inventory for service parts will not be reordered. Our store will continue to stock staple items, such as toilet paper, chemical, common RV parts and accessories, and of course some snacks and drinks.

We wish everyone a happy and healthy new year and hope to see you all return for 2026. If you are not returning for this year, please have your site cleared by April 1st and let us know so we can give new campers every option possible for their site. For those of you who are staying and wish to move to a new campsite, please let us know you are interested in moving and we will be calling closer to March with the options that are available.
